



BV Apparel and Equipment Policy



TEAM APPAREL - ADRENALIN SOURCE FOR SPORTS

Adrenalin Source of Sports is the official apparel provider of the Bow Valley Hockey Society. No other individual and or company has permission to use the BV logo and or name. All team-level apparel must be ordered through Adrenalin Source for Sports as per our agreement. This includes apparel paid through team-level sponsorships.

Failure to follow this agreement may result in the Head Coach being suspended for a minimum of 5 games at the discretion of the BVHS Board of Directors.

In the event a team fails to follow these guidelines and orders third jerseys through another provider, the BVHS Board of Directors has the discretion to mandate that the team wear their BV-issued jerseys for the remainder of the season.

JERSEYS

The following guidelines have been set into place regarding our BVHS team issued jerseys.

- A. Name bars are not permitted to be placed on BVHS jerseys.
- B. Team-level advertising on BVHS jerseys is not permitted.
- C. All jerseys are to be returned to BVHS at the conclusion of each respective season in numerical order and ensure they have been washed.
- D. U7 Jerseys are to be given to the players on a two-year rotation at the direction of Hockey Calgary. These details are communicated to the respective teams on an annual basis.
- E. U7 teams must wear their Timbits jerseys for all games and practices as per the sponsorship agreement with Hockey Calgary.
- E. U11 Jerseys – Through the ATOMC program the U11 players are given one jersey to keep on an annual basis. This is communicated to the respective teams on an annual basis.
- F. U9 and U11 House Teams keep their jerseys at the conclusion of each season.
- G. Any unnecessary damages to BVHS jerseys will be the team's responsibility for covering replacement costs.



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JERSEY PARENTS

Community Teams

U7 – Players are permitted to keep their jerseys for the duration of the season and are responsible for the care and washing of their respective jersey. Parents are required to return the jerseys washed at the conclusion of the season.

U9 – U18 – Each team is required to have jersey parents to care for the respective jerseys. It is recommended that each team has two jersey parents, one for the home jerseys and one for the away jerseys. Jerseys are to be washed in cold water and hung to dry.

House Teams

U9 and U11 house teams are permitted to keep their jerseys for the duration of the season and are responsible for the care and washing of their respective jersey.

TEAM PURCHASED JERSEYS

Teams may purchase third jerseys through Adrenalin Source for Sports for their own sets of jerseys or a single third set of jerseys with team or donated funds (“team owned jerseys”), provided the jerseys are first approved by the BVHS Manager of Hockey Operations and are consistent with BVHS standard uniforms.

The team-owned jerseys may have name bars applied to the jerseys.

Any advertising on team-owned jerseys must be approved by the BVHS Manager of Hockey Operations before being worn by any BVHS team in a game.

Advertising thought to be inappropriate for children to be wearing will not be permitted.

APPAREL OTHER THAN JERSEYS

Any advertising on any equipment other than jerseys (i.e., off ice apparel, helmets, gloves, pants, pant shells, socks, or skates) must be approved by the BVHS Manager of Hockey Operations before being worn by any BVHS. Advertising thought to be inappropriate for children to be wearing will not be permitted. In an age group with an established BVHS Advertising Partner, only very subtle advertising may be permitted, if at all.

BVHS EQUIPMENT

BVHS teams are required to ensure that the BV equipment supplied to the teams is kept in good order, and the quantities given out are the quantities returned at the conclusion of each respective season. Teams are required to use team funds to replace any shortfalls. Any items that are lost, are to be replaced at the expense of the respective team.



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Each team will receive the following at equipment pick up:

- 1 Coaches Book for lines ups
- 3 Sticker Sheets for C and A's (U11 – U18 Teams)
- 60 Blue Pucks for U7 and U9
- 60 Black Pucks U11 – U18 Teams (U9 Teams can request black pucks)
- 60 Pylons
- First Aid Kit

U9 Goalie Gear

U9 Teams receive two sets of goalie gear. Each goalie bag has a number and a letter associated with it.

Each team receives the following goalie gear:

- two left-handed sticks
- one right-handed stick.
- two sets of left-handed catchers
- two right-handed blockers
- 1 right-handed catcher
- 1 left-handed blocker
- Each bag has a goalie neck guard
- Each bag has a dangler for throat protection
- Each bag has a set of knee pads.

U9 Goalie Gear Sanitization Community Teams

All BVHS U9 Community teams are required to use team funds to clean the goalie gear at the conclusion of each respective season. Teams are encouraged to use team funds to have the gear sanitized throughout the season for sanitary purposes.

U9 Goalie Gear Sanitization House League Teams

BVHS will facilitate the cleaning of the U9 House Teams goalie gear at the conclusion of the season.



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As the Head Coach of the respective team, I acknowledged that I have read and understand the BVHS Apparel and Equipment Policy as outlined.

I take responsibility for ensuring that the guidelines within this policy are followed throughout the course of the season.

I acknowledge that Adrenalin Source for Sports is the exclusive apparel provider for all BVHS Apparel and all team level apparel including but not limited to sponsored apparel must be ordered through Adrenalin Source for Sports and I understand that I may be subject to suspension if the team breaches this policy.

I acknowledge that the BV Board of Directors has the authority to mandate that we wear our BV issued game jerseys in the event we ordered third jerseys through a provider outside of Adrenalin Source for Sports.

I acknowledge that we are required to care for the jerseys as outlined within this policy and it's my responsibility to ensure our jersey parents are aware of how to care for these jerseys.

I acknowledge that we are required to return the quantities of equipment at the conclusion of the season as outlined within this policy.
